Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must be on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on 31 May 2017. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot get to the polling station in person after 5pm on 31 May 2017.
