NATIONAL FRAUD INITIATIVE – DATA MATCHING EXERCISE FAIR PROCESSING NOTICE

Under Part 6 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014, Arun District Council is legally required to provide data to the Cabinet Office for the purposes of the National Fraud Initiative (NFI).

The information submitted will be used by the Cabinet Office to perform data matching exercises to assist in the prevention and detection of fraud.

The information submitted by the Council will be compared against data supplied from other sources and matches found will be referred back to the originating organisation to investigate further. The use of data in this way is permitted under the Data Protection Act 1998.

On an annual basis, the Cabinet Office undertakes data matching in respect of Council Tax single person discount entitlement with the Council supplying data (next due in October / December 2017) in respect of:-

- council tax
- electoral register.

The main NFI exercise takes place every 2 years. The next data required will be supplied during October 2018
