### **Arun Local Plan Examination**

Thank you for your letter dated 27 November setting out further matters to address in the process of the Examination of the Arun Local Plan. The following responses or attachments as indicated, address the issues raised.

Evidence documents – the web site is now up to date with the evidence documents that have been produced to date including SEDP7 WSCC note on primary school provision. To confirm the Enterprise Bognor Regis Transport Review 2017 is document PECP10. Where this document has been updated since the version published prior to the Examination is to be shown in a schedule at the front of the document. ADC agree and will make it clear in the consultation information for the Main Modifications that representations can be made on these documents alongside those on the MM's.

The reference to PESP6 Angmering North Allocations Landscape Assessment has been added to the ADC answer to paragraph 23 in the actions list.

A note has been produced for the Yapton site which explains the allocation process in this locality and lists the relevant evidence documents that deal with the allocation.

The Schedule of MM's has been updated taking into account all of the Inspectors comments and/or following the principles in the bullet points set out on page two of the letter. A word version of the document has been produced. The Additional Modifications table has similarly been updated and improved.

The collaboration work between ADC and WSCC is explained in the attached note. In summary, as a result of the considerable amount of joint work that was being undertaken by both parties a Memorandum of Understanding was not considered to be required by both parties.

A note about the implications on the Arun Local Plan of the Adur Local Plan recently being found sound and the publication of the Government's 'Planning for the right homes in the

right places' is attached. In summary there are no further implications for the Arun Local Plan as a result.

A new Programme Officer, Chris Banks of Banks Solutions has been appointed. This information is on the ADC Examination web page.

The Council will be producing an updated version of the Local Plan showing all Main Modifications that are proposed since the previous March 2017 consultation version to aid the public in the consultation process. This is attached for reference for the Inspector.
