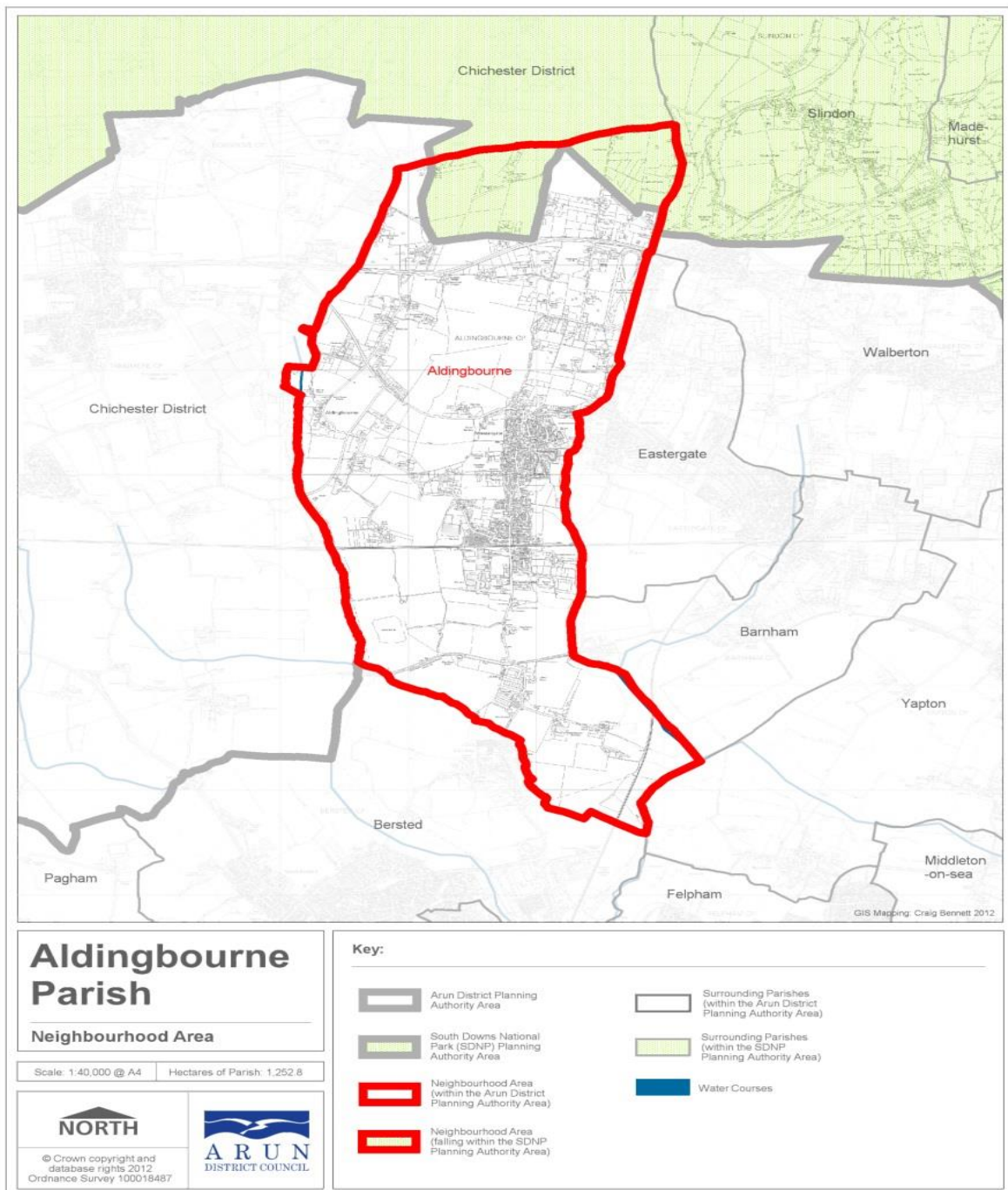
Referendum : 18th October 2016



A neighbourhood planning referendum will be held for the Aldingbourne Neighbourhood Development Plan 2014-2034 on 18th October 2016. The question asked in the referendum will be:

Do you want Arun District Council and the South Downs National Park Authority to use the neighbourhood plan for Aldingbourne to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?"

The referendum area and the area covered by the neighbourhood plan is the parish area of Aldingbourne (see map below).



A person is entitled to vote in the Referendum if on 18th October 2016

- he or she is entitled to vote in a local government election in the Referendum area; and
- his or her qualifying address for the election is in the Referendum area. A persons qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, the address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be registered.

The Referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the Referendum is £2,541.60.

The number of persons entitled to vote in the Referendum by reference to which the limit has been calculated is 3,044.

The Referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures which are similar to those used at local government elections.

The specified documents are the:

- Draft Aldingbourne Neighbourhood Development Plan
- Report of the independent examiner
- Summary of the representations submitted to the independent examiner
- Statement by the local planning authority that the draft plan meets the basic conditions (Decision statement)
- Statement that sets out general information as to town and country planning including neighbourhood planning and the referendum (information for voters)
