ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION IN DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES ORDER 2006

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Arun District Council (“The Council”) has made the following Order under section 13(2) of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 (“the Act”):

1. The land described in the schedule below being land in the area of the Council which is land to which the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 applies, are designated for the purposes of the Act.
2. The Order may be cited as the Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Places (Arun) Order 2006 and shall come into force on 1st June 2005.

The effect of the Order is to designate specific areas in the Arun District as described in the schedule below. In these areas any person who continues drinking intoxicating liquor in a designated area when asked to desist by a Police Officer under section 12(2)(a) or fails to surrender any intoxicating liquor in his possession when asked to do so by a Police Officer under section 12(2)(b) commits an offence as follows:

Any person who fails without reasonable excuse to comply with a requirement imposed on them under Section 12(2) of the Act commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £500 [Section 12(4)].

SCHEDULE

LAND INCLUDED IN THE DESIGNATION ORDER

Littlehampton DPPO Boundary

Ward / Area

Littlehampton

North from West Beach following the west side of Rope Walk, continuing over Ferry Road, and following north alongside the west side of the River Arun until joining the A259 to the superstore/retail park roundabout.

Wick

Continuing along the A259 northwards along the Wick bypass.
North from the corner of the A259 past the west side of Courtwick Park until the train line

Toddington

Following the north side of the train line to the east until the train line crosses the A259 along the Rustington bypass.

Rustington

East Preston

Kingston

Along the north side of the A259 to the east, including New Road and Roundstone By-Pass Road and Littlehampton Road.

Ferring

Along Littlehampton Road (A259) until going southwards down Ferring Lane, over the railway line, through Singleton Crescent following the ward boundary.

South over Goring way, east side of the school and over Midhurst Drive following directly southwards east of Sea Lane to the beach.

Bognor Regis DPPO Boundary

Ward / Area

Pagham

North from Harbour Road, following the eastern edge of Pagham Lagoon, going north and continuing along the western side of Church Close, intersecting Church Lane and continuing along the western side of Pagham Road.

Nyetimber

Along the western side of Pagham Road until Sefter Road

Rose Green

Following the northernmost side of Sefter Road to the east into Rose Green Road, Hewarts Lane and Chalcraft Lane.

North Bersted

Continuing along Chalcraft Lane and heading due north at the cemetery until intersecting Newbarn Lane, continuing east along Brazwick Avenue, intersecting Chichester Road. Continuing south along the easternmost side of Chichester Road.

Continuing eastwards along the northernmost side of North Bersted Street and Rowan Way, intersecting A29 Shripney Road, following the northernmost side of Steyning Way, along Beeding Close to the east side of the railway line.

South Bersted

Continuing in a southwards direction along the eastern side of the railway line until Whitfield Close, Brooks Lane and Marylands Crescent, proceeding eastwards across the back of Arun Leisure Centre and the school playing fields to join Golf Links Road.

Felpham

North along Golf Links Road following the northernmost side of Shirley Drive, Lindsey Ct, Bala Crescent, Westmorland Drive, Coniston Close, Norman's Drive, north edge of Lionel Avenue

Flansham

North at intersection of Lionel Avenue, following the A259 Flansham Lane and Worms Lane continuing along the northernmost side.

Middleton-on-Sea

Proceeding south along the eastern side of the B2132 Yapton Road until Ancton Lane, following the northern side of Ancton Lane to incorporate

Ancton

The northernmost points of Kingsmead Gardens, Sunnymead Close.

Following the northernmost side of Ancton Way, south along The Hard joining Elmer Court and due south to the beach.
